## Description

Front: Kopf des Domitianus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Iupiter sitzt nach l. mit Victoria in der r. und Zepter in der l. Hand. Darunter S C.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
