## Description

Front: Kopf des Nerva mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Iustitia thront nach r. In ihrer vorgestreckten r. Hand hält sie einen Zweig, die erhobene l. Hand stützt sie auf ein Zepter.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Gilded: With an overlay (wholly or in parts) of a thin layer of gold. Process is not part of the regular production.
