Description

Front: Kopf des Traianus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Pax steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l., im l. Arm Füllhorn (cornucopiae), in der r. Hand Zweig.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
