Description

Front: Bekränzter Kopf des Domitian nach r.

Rear: Ein Ludio schreitet nach l. mit einem Stab in seiner r. und einem Schild in seiner verdeckten l. Hand.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
