Description

Janke's drawings of machines are partly based on developments of his time, which he wanted to think further functionally into new application areas, also for the context of the Hubertusburger Clinic-Everyday.

The concrete functionality flows here, however, with the utopian dimension of his work and his vision of Raumelektrizität together.

Beyond that, Janke's fight for the recognition of his realities is implicitly also mediated through the dimension of the Aesthetic. This question of „Design“ brings together the various fields of his artistic research and makes the utopian horizon visible, which also goes beyond the functional here.
