## Description

Janke's drawings of machines feed partly into developments of his time, which he functionally thought through for new application areas, also for the context of the Hubertusburger Clinic's daily life.

The concrete functionality flows here, however, together with the utopian dimension of his work and his vision of Raumelektrizität.

Beyond that, Janke's work implicitly also conveys the recognition of his realities through the dimension of the aesthetic. This question of „Design“ brings together the various fields of his artistic research and makes the utopian horizon visible, which also goes beyond the functional.
